

## INSTRUCTIONS TO SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT

To be eligible to apply, the applicant must be a member in good standing of a Bethel in Colorado for at least two years prior to the date of her application. Daughters up to age 25 may apply, given they have been active in a Bethel in the past 2 years. (This includes attendance and does not necessarily mean a council position).

- An applicant is not eligible for a scholarship if receives an award or scholarship of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) or more from one source.

### Your application for scholarship must include:

- Application form COMPLETELY filled out using black ink (you may use the fillable form and type the application), signed and a photograph of the applicant included.
- An OFFICIAL transcript of grades of the applicant. High school graduates must send grades from all completed work through the last semester.
- Applications must be accompanied by recommendations from at least three of the five (5) Executive members of the Bethel Guardian Council, a letter from a teacher or administrator of a school attended on school letterhead and at least one other character reference (i.e. minister, employer or friend of the family, etc.)
  - Letters must be signed by the originator or will not be considered. Persons other than the applicant must fill out and sign the requested documents 5 through 8 on the application checklist. The applicant is responsible for having documents mailed to the Grand Secretary or enclosing them with the application that she mails. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE APPLICANT FOLLOW THROUGH ON THE ABOVE TO MAKE SURE ALL DOUCUMENTS ARE ENCLOSED AND MAILED ON TIME.
- All documents of applicants for scholarship (including the application) are to be received by the Grand Secretary no later than **April 1<sup>st</sup>** of that year.
- All material will become the property of the Board of Educational Trustees and will not be returned. The decision of the Board Committee is final.
- Notification of award will be sent to winners by May 15<sup>th</sup> of that year.
- A Job's Daughter is eligible to receive only one scholarship a year from the Grand Guardian Council.
- The Board of education Trustees evaluates and judges all applications as follows:
  - Job's Daughters Activities Maximum 500 points
  - Scholastic Record Maximum 250 points
  - Church, clubs, civic achievements, work, etc. Maximum 150 points
  - In addition to the above point ratings, consideration shall be given to the need of the applicant. Maximum 100 points

8. One character reference from a minister, employer or friend of the family. \_\_\_\_\_

\*All letters must be signed by the originator, or they will not be considered.

**NOTE:** Persons other than the applicant must fill out the above documents, namely numbers 5 through

The applicant is responsible for having all documents completed and enclosed with the application.

**It is imperative that the applicant follow through on the above to make sure all documents are enclosed in her packet or mailed to the Grand Secretary on time (APRIL 1, 2025). NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
